The Culpeper County Volunteer Fire Department is not a seller, manufacturer or seller in smoke detectors or batteries and that it makes no warranties with regard to these products.

In exchange for accepting of the free smoke detector(s) with or without installation agree not to make any claims or demands or to file any lawsuit against Culpeper County Volunteer Fire Department or any their volunteers or assisting organizations. Any individuals serving as a volunteer with the department of any individual who is involved with the Smoke Detector Program, for any injuries, deaths, damages, cost or expenses claimed to have resulted from the smoke detector(s) battery (ies), from their installation or from the instructions for maintenance and safety given at the time of installation as well as any other claims. I hereby waive any cause of action that I may have now or in the future or that anyone else may have by or through me, arising out of the malfunctioning of the smoke detector(s) or the battery(ies), whether or not used accordance with manufacturer's instructions. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Culpeper County Volunteer Fire Department, its members, agents, and assigning organizations as to any such claim that may be brought by other parties. I further understand for these smoke detectors to be effective, the audible alarm needs to be checked monthly and batteries replaced at least once per year with proper type and proper installation of battery. **This release from liability is binding on me and my family and my heirs, successors and assigns.**
